
ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, to wit, this 8th day of April, 2016, the Court notes and directs as follows:

1. Plaintiff, Graham B. Spanier, filed a civil Complaint against Defendant, The Pennsylvania State University, on February 10, 2016.
2. Defendant accepted service of the Complaint on February 24, 2016, at which time the parties filed a stipulation that granted Defendant until March 31, 2016 to file a response to the Complaint.
3. Defendant filed Preliminary Objections to Plaintiff's Complaint, along with a supporting Memorandum, on March 31, 2016.
4. Under Rule 1028(c)(1), Plaintiff may file an Amended Complaint as a matter of course within twenty (20) days of service of the Preliminary Objections.
5. In the event the Plaintiff does not file an Amended Complaint within that time period, the Court sets the following briefing and argument schedule on Defendant's Preliminary Objections:

- a. Plaintiff shall file a Memorandum in response to the Preliminary Objections on or before May 16, 2016.
 - b. Defendant may file a Reply Memorandum on or before May 31, 2016.
 - c. Oral Argument on the Preliminary Objections shall be held on July 25, 2016, at 10 o'clock a.m. in Courtroom 1, 102 S. Allegheny Street, Bellefonte, Pennsylvania.
