- 1. "You," "your," and "yours" shall refer to Fred S. Berlin, and all other persons acting on behalf of Fred S. Berlin, including but not limited to, attorneys and their associates, investigators, agents, directors, officers, employees, representatives, and others who may have obtained information for or on behalf of Fred S. Berlin.
- "Plaintiffs" shall mean each of the individuals identified in the caption above, any
 representative of those individuals, and any representatives of the Estate and Family of
 Joseph Paterno.
- 3. "All" or "any" shall mean "each and every."
- 4. "And" and "or" shall mean either disjunctively or conjunctively as necessary to bring within the scope of discovery request all responses that might otherwise be construed outside of its scope.
- 5. "Document" or "documents" is defined as broadly as possible, and is defined to include originals and copies (including all non-identical copies or photocopies) as well as all draft and final versions of, without limitation: (a) All writings of any kind (including the originals and all non-identical copies, whether different from the originals by reason of any notation made on such copies or otherwise), including, without limitation, correspondence, notes, statements, transcripts, books, diaries, intra-office communications, notations of any sort of conversations or interviews; (b) All graphic representations of any kind, including, without limitation, photographs, charts, graphs, plans, drawings, videos, and recordings; and (c) All electronically generated and/or stored correspondence, memoranda, communications, data compilations, or

- 11. The "Freeh Report" shall mean the July 12, 2012 Report of the Special Investigative Counsel Regarding the Actions of The Pennsylvania State University Related to the Child Sexual Abuse Committed by Gerald A. Sandusky, prepared by FSS.
- 12. The "Consent Decree" shall mean the July 23, 2012 Binding Consent Decree Imposed by the National Collegiate Athletic Association and Accepted by The Pennsylvania State University.
- 13. The "Berlin Report" shall mean Your February 6, 2013 letter to J. Sedwick Sollers, III

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.
