Dear Judge Leete:

On December 17, 2014, Defendant the National Collegiate Athletic Association ("NCAA"), Dr. Mark Emmert, and Dr. Ed Ray (collectively, the "NCAA Defendants") filed a motion to postpone the January 5, 2015 hearing that this Court scheduled in its order of December 10, 2014. The NCAA requested the postponement on the grounds that the trial in Corman v. NCAA, No. 1 MD 2013, before the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania, was scheduled to commence on January 6, 2015. Penn State concurred in the request for postponement, and plaintiffs did not oppose.

The NCAA wishes to notify the Court that, on December 18, 2014, the Commonwealth Court sua sponte rescheduled the trial to start on February 17, 2015. The order is attached. When the NCAA filed its December 17 motion for postponement in this case, it had no knowledge or expectation that the Commonwealth Court was considering rescheduling the trial in the Corman matter.

Notwithstanding the rescheduled trial date in Corman, the NCAA respectfully requests that the Court postpone the January 5, 2015 hearing date, as originally requested in the NCAA's December 17 motion. The Commonwealth Court's decision to move the trial has required counsel to readjust their schedules accordingly, including moving a long-planned family vacation. The only practicable time to reschedule that vacation would be early January 2015. Therefore, if it would not be inconvenient for this Court, the NCAA continues to request that the January 5, 2015 hearing date be rescheduled for any time after January 20, 2015. Penn State concurs in this request. Counsel for the Paterno Estate has communicated to the NCAA that the Estate does not oppose the request, and counsel for other plaintiffs concur in this request.
