ORDER


AND NOW, November 25, 2015, pursuant to a conference call held his day on outstanding discovery matters, it is ordered that counsel meet and discuss outstanding discovery issues, the same to occur within 20 days of this date. Counsel will promptly advise the court of any progress after the meeting.

As to the issues relating to the discovery of University police reports unrelated in any way to the Sandusky matter, the request of plaintiff for access to these reports is denied. The Court with holds ruling on the issues of items designated "highly confidential-attorneys eye only" pending the attempts of the parties to resolve the same in accordance with this Order. Counsel for the NCAA may take part if they choose.

As to the request of the University to utilize the claw back provisions of the stipulated confidentiality order of September 11, 2014, the same is denied on the basis that all of this

material was previously made available to plaintiffs through other discovery. Said items will, however, be designated as "confidential" in compliance with the confidentiality agreement.
