PEPPER HAMILTON LLP AND THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE UNIVERSITY'S CONCISE STATEMENT OF ERRORS COMPLAINED OF ON APPEAL

In accordance with the Court's Order entered August 4, 2015, and Pa. R. App. P. 1925(b), Non-Parties Pepper Hamilton LLP ("Pepper Hamilton") and The Pennsylvania State University ("Penn State," and, collectively with Pepper Hamilton, "Appellants"), by and through their counsel, hereby submit this concise statement of errors complained of on appeal that individually or cumulatively warrant reversal of the Order and Opinion entered on May 8, 2015 granting Plaintiffs' Motion for Enforcement of Subpoena Directed to Pepper Hamilton:

1. The Court erred in granting the motion to enforce the subpoena served on Pepper Hamilton, thereby compelling Pepper Hamilton to produce documents protected by the

attorney-client privilege and/or the work product doctrine, prior to the Superior Court's

resolution of the appeal pending in this Court at Case No. 1709 MDA 2014, in which Penn State

has challenged the Court's erroneous holdings that: (a) documents sought by Plaintiffs are not

protected by the attorney-client privilege and/or the work product doctrine and (b) even if the

documents were privileged, the privileges have been waived.
