
[PROPOSED] SCHEDULING ORDER

Upon consideration of the parties' joint motion for entry of a scheduling order, and the reasons contained therein, the motion is hereby GRANTED. This 12 day of Oct., 2015, it is hereby ordered that:

1. The parties shall complete all fact discovery by February 29, 2016.

2. Defendants Emmert and Ray shall file supplemental briefs in support of their preliminary objections concerning personal jurisdiction by February 29, 2016; Plaintiffs shall file oppositions to such preliminary objections by April 6, 2016; and all reply briefs in support of such preliminary objections shall be filed by April 20, 2016.
3. Plaintiffs shall make their expert witness disclosures by March 30, 2016, and Defendants shall do the same by April 29, 2016.
4. Plaintiffs will provide any supplemental expert disclosures by May 13, 2016; Defendants will provide any supplemental expert disclosures by May 27, 2016.
5. The parties shall file all dispositive motions and supporting briefs on or before July 8, 2016.
6. All responsive briefs to dispositive motions will be filed on or before August 5, 2016.
7. All reply briefs in support of dispositive motions will be filed on or before August 19, 2016.

Based on the Court's resolution of the outstanding scheduling issues, which will be addressed in the parties' forthcoming position statements, additional dates may be added to this case schedule.
