COMMONWEALTH'S MOTION TO PRECLUDE IMPROPER USE OF SUBPOENA POWER BY DEFENDANT

AND NOW, this 27th day of April, 2012, comes the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by and through the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania who presents the within Motion to Preclude Improper Use of Subpoena Power by Defendant and respectfully avers as follows:

- For the reasons articulated below, and in the interests of justice, the Commonwealth
 respectfully requests that this Honorable Court grant its Motion to Preclude Improper
 Use of Subpoena Power by Defendant.
- 2. The Commonwealth believes, and therefore avers, that defense counsel in this matter has obtained from Centre County numerous generic form subpoenas produced by the County for use by litigants in civil and criminal trials.
- 3. The Commonwealth further avers that defense counsel has exploited these forms, which carry the imprimatur of the County and the name of its President Judge, in an effort to circumvent this Honorable Court's rulings and those of the Grand Jury Supervising Judge.

- 4. The Commonwealth further avers that such ostensible subpoenas have already been directed to the Pennsylvania State Police and its Commissioner Frank Noonan (Attached as Exhibit "A"); the Superintendent of the Central Mountain School District (Exhibit "B"); the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry (Exhibit "C"); the Penn State University Police Department (Exhibit "D"); and to officers of the Second Mile organization.
- 5. The Commonwealth avers that the subpoenas directed to the Pennsylvania State Police and to Penn State University Police were sent with an attachment, behind this court's Order of March 13 concerning the protection of the identities of the victims, revealing the victims' names and their dates of birth. (The Commonwealth has removed that attachment from its Exhibit "A.") The Subpoena to the Department of Labor and Industry includes this information in the cover letter, following a wan admonition to adhere to this court's Order. (That information has been redacted from Exhibit "C.") The Commonwealth need not underscore to this Honorable Court the spectacular irresponsibility of treating secret information in that fashion.
- 6. The Commonwealth believes, and therefore avers, many other *ersatz* subpoenas of this type are being sent by defense counsel to various other individuals and organizations.
- 7. The Commonwealth respectfully submits that this use of the subpoena power by Defendant is manifestly improper, lacks any basis whatsoever in the law of this Commonwealth, and is a misappropriation of the authority of this Honorable Court.
- 8. The defects in these purported subpoenas are legion: First, they direct the recipient to appear on May 16, 2012, the date set for a status conference in this matter. They

- direct the subject to appear "to testify on behalf of Defendant" on that date; this despite the fact that no testimony will be taken on that day.
- 9. These subpoenas are further styled duces tecum and are stated in the broadest terms imaginable. Incredibly, they purport to direct the Pennsylvania State Police to appear with its complete, unreducted investigative file. This notwithstanding the fact that it self-evidently contains materials protected by the Grand Jury Act and which are the subject of previous orders by the Supervising Judge.
- 10. The subpoena directed to the Department of Labor and Industry inexplicably states that "if [the information requested] is provided to me . . . it will not be necessary for a representative of your department to appear in court"
- 11. Each subpoena follows the same "any and all" formula and can have no other purpose than to gather to Defendant material to which he is not entitled.
- 12. It is axiomatic that "subpoenas are not to be used to compel production of documents merely for inspection or for a 'fishing expedition'." *Commonwealth v. McEnany* 446 Pa.Super. 609, 620, 667 A.2d 1143, 1149 (1995)(internal citations omitted).
- 13. The Commonwealth further submits that no legal authority exists for this particular use of the subpoena power to direct the subject to appear, not for trial, but on the date of an administrative conference and to produce material with no demonstrable relevance.
- 14. The Commonwealth acknowledges Defendant's Due Process rights, and will continue to proceed in a manner which ensures he receives a fair trial. However, as our courts have held, those rights "do[] not mean that a defendant has unfettered access to files not in his possession. Nor can a defendant search untrammeled through Commonwealth files in order to argue the relevance of materials found therein."

- Commonwealth v. Herrick, 442 Pa.Super. 412, 431, 660 A.2d 51, 61 (Pa.Super. 1995)(internal citations omitted).
- 15. The Commonwealth respectfully submits that Defendant must at least attempt to make a threshold demonstration of relevance and propriety to this Honorable Court before purporting to issue catch-all subpoenas in its name.
- 16. Because no legal basis exists upon which to serve the instant subpoenas; because they abuse the process of this Honorable Court and our Rules of Criminal Procedure to seek material for precisely the kind of 'fishing expedition' proscribed by our law; and because they seek to subvert the rulings of this Honorable Court and those of the Supervising Judge, the Commonwealth respectfully requests that Defendant be directed immediately to cease the production of these subpoenas and to withdraw those already served. The Commonwealth respectfully requests that Defendant be directed to submit to the court the purported relevance and, in the case of grand jury materials, legal authority for future requests of this type.

WHEREFORE, the Commonwealth respectfully requests that this Honorable Court direct defense counsel immediately to cease production of these subpoenas which are being served under the authority of this Honorable Court and to require Defendant to make the appropriate demonstration to this Court of the basis of future documentary requests.
