I am aware that formal arraignment has been scheduled at the Centre County Courthouse, Bellefonte, Pennsylvania, for (date) 1/11/12, and that I have the right to appear at that time for arraignment on the District Attorney's "Information" filed against me containing the following charges:

I am aware that certain pre-trial motions may be filed:

- a) A Bill of Particulars must be filed within seven (7) days;
- b) A motion for discovery and inspection of Commonwealth's evidence within fourteen (14) days (NOTE: before this motion can be filed with the Court, an informal request in writing to the District Attorney must be made and refused);
- c) An omnibus pre-trial motion for relief within thirty (30) days, including but not limited to motions for a continuance, severance, suppression of evidence, psychiatric examination, to quash the information, for change of venue, to disqualify a judge, for appointment of investigator, and for a pre-trial conference.

If these motions are not filed within the time limits set forth above, I will forever waive or give up my right to file them. All time limits shall be calculated from the date of formal arraignment set forth above.

Having considered all of the above, I hereby waive court arraignment. I understand that by executing this waiver I give up the right to be arraigned in open court.

The following must be completed and returned to the office of the Court Administrator five (5) days before the scheduled arraignment date. If this form is not completed and returned as noted, the Defendant MUST appear for arraignment as so notified:
