O R D E R

AND NOW, September 20, 2017, in lieu of argument and in accordance with the agreement and stipulation of the attorneys for both parties, the Court notes and directs as follows:

1. The parties are in agreement that the Plaintiff's conviction for Endangering the Welfare of Children in the criminal action related to the underlying facts in the within matter is dispositive of the claims raised by Plaintiff herein.

2. The Court is advised that an appeal has been lodged with the Superior Court of Pennsylvania by Plaintiff from the conviction referenced above.

3. The action of the Court today is based upon the agreement and stipulation of the parties as to the applicability and effect of Plaintiff's conviction in that criminal matter.

4. Accordingly, Defendants' Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings is GRANTED as to all named defendants.

5. The Plaintiff shall reserve the opportunity to present a motion to this Court seeking to have this judgment set aside in the event of a determination by the Appellate Court in the companion criminal case overturning Plaintiff's conviction.

6. In the event that this judgment is set aside at any point as indicated by the process above, all issues presented in the current Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings are preserved and may be re-presented for consideration by this Court.
