

RESOLUTION # 6 OF 2009

WHEREAS, the county of Centre recognizes the need to provide Community Development assistance for infrastructure improvements throughout the County, and

WHEREAS, the County is able to positively respond to the water system needs of Rush, Burnside, Howard, and Miles Townships and Port Matilda Borough, and sanitary sewer system improvements in Burnside and Worth Townships, and

WHEREAS, the US Congress passed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 and through the PA Department of Community & Economic Development, Centre County has received an additional \$80,320 in CDBG funding and therefore Centre County must amend RESOLUTION # 3 OF 2009,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Centre submit an application, including all understandings and assurances contained therein to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for approximately \$461,243 in Pennsylvania Community Development Block Grant funds to make feasible the Community Development projects described in the County's FFY 2009 application to the Commonwealth and

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that Robert Jacobs, Director of the Centre County Planning and Community Development Office be identified as the official representative of the County for the CDBG Entitlement Program and that he be hereby authorized and directed to act in connection with the application and to provide additional information as may be required.
